Thursday, October 7, 2010

Depart USA

Today we board our transatlantic flight to Warsaw.

Friday, October 8, 2010

Arrive Warsaw

(D)

Upon arrival in Warsaw, meet our Polish tour escort and transfer to our hotel in the heart of Warsaw. This afternoon, **celebrate Mass the Church of St. Stanislaw Kostka**, where outside is the tomb of Fr. Jerzy Popieluszko, chaplain and martyr of the Solidarity Movement. After Mass, explore the museum of Fr. Popieluszko. Next, visit the reconstructed Warsaw Old Town featuring colorful houses, art galleries and quaint restaurants. (*Note: activities today depend on the actual flight arrival time.*) Enjoy a festive welcome dinner at one of the special restaurants in the Old City. Overnight Warsaw.

Saturday, October 9, 2010

Warsaw

(CB)

Depart to Niepokolanow – the Immaculata city, built by Fr. Maximilian Kolbe. **Celebrate Mass at the Shrine of Fr. Maximilian Kolbe**. Return to Warsaw for a city sightseeing tour that introduces us to the most important sights of the capital city of Poland. Raised from the ashes of World War II, we begin our tour at St. John's Cathedral, where Servant of God, Stefan Cardinal Wyszyński, is buried. Also see the Royal Castle Square, which features the magnificent royal residence and Sigmund Column. There will be free time for lunch on your own before continuing our tour with the Jewish Quarter and Warsaw Uprising monument and museum. Late afternoon, we arrive at the beautiful Lazienki Park and Palace, former summer residence of the Polish King. While in the Park, see the famous Chopin Monument. Dinner on your own and overnight Warsaw.

Sunday, October 10, 2010

Warsaw/Czestochowa/Kraków

(CB, D)

Depart Warsaw for Czestochowa. Late morning arrival in Czestochowa, the center of Poland's religious life and home of the famous icon of the Black Madonna. Take a guided tour of the Shrine and attend the unvieling of the Icon of the Black Madonna. Lunch on your own before **celebrating Mass at the Shrine**. Depart for Krakow for dinner at the hotel and overnight.

Monday, October 11, 2010

Kraków/Wadowice/Kraków

(B, D)

Depart Krakow for Wadowice, birthplace of John Paul II. **Celebrate Mass at the local church where Pope John Paul II was baptized: Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary**. Lunch on your own. Return to Krakow for an orientation tour of the Karzmiarz quarter. Dinner at the hotel and overnight in Krakow.

Tuesday, October 12, 2010

Kraków/ Wawel Hill/Divine Mercy Center/Kraków

Celebrate the 31st anniversary of the historic election of Karol Cardinal Wojtyła, Archbishop of Kraków, to the Papacy, with Mass at the Wawel Cathedral Pope John Paul where II was ordained priest and celebrated his first Mass. Tour Wawel Hill and Cathedral to see the tombs of St. Stanislaw and St. Hedwig. It is also the final resting place of Polish kings, poets and national heroes. This afternoon, attend the opening of the Witt Stwoszcz altar at the Mariacki Church (St. Mary's Church). Lunch on your own at Krakow Market Square, then travel to the tomb of St. Faustina Kowalska where we will **pray the Divine Mercy Novena**. Then, tour the convent and the Basilica of the Divine Mercy which was consecrated by the Servant of God, John Paul II, during his last trip to Poland. Return to your hotel. Dinner on your own and overnight Krakow

Wednesday, October 13, 2010

Kraków/Zakopane/Kraków

(CB, D)

Depart for the scenic hills of Zakopane. **Celebrate Mass at Fatima Church** which was built by the mountaineers in gratitude for the Blessed Mother saving the life of Pope John Paul II from the assassination attempt. Take the Gondolas to Mt Glubowka for a bird's eye view over the city and hillsides of Zakopane. Tour of the city followed by lunch on your own. This afternoon there will be time for strolling and shopping on Krupowki Street. Return to Krakow for dinner at the hotel. Overnight in Krakow.

Thursday, October 14, 2010

Kraków/Salt Mine/Kalwaria/Kraków

(CB)

Depart for Wieliczka for a guided tour of the World Famous Salt Mines. Lunch on your own. This afternoon visit Kalwaria – the Polish Jerusalem. The shrine is dedicated to the Passion of Christ and also to the miraculous Icon of the Virgin Mary. **Celebrate Mass at the Shrine**. Return to Krakow for dinner on your own. Overnight in Krakow.

Friday, October 15, 2010

Kraków/Auschwitz/Kraków

(CB, D)

Depart for Auschwitz. Time on your own this morning at the concentration camp. **Celebrate Mass at St Maximilian Kolbe Shrine** at Hamrze, Auschwitz. Lunch on your own before returning to Krakow. Farewell dinner tonight at the famous fourteenth century restaurant, "Wierzynek," where kings and presidents have dined. Overnight in Krakow.

Saturday, October 16, 2010

Return to USA

Following a spiritually moving journey to the homeland of Pope John Paul II, transfer to the airport in Krakow for return flight to the USA.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

PAYMENT: In order to meet deposit schedules with suppliers for this tour, Corporate Travel Service asks for prompt payment on the requested dates. Please see the reservation form for the payment schedule. The advertised price is based on 45 passengers, tariffs, exchange rates, air line fuel surcharges and taxes in effect when the tour was organized and are subject to increase before tour departure. Price of the tour may have to be adjusted before final payment to reflect any increase in tariffs, fluctuation in exchange rates and/or fuel surcharges.

Corporate Travel Service accepts cash, check, money orders and Visa and MasterCard for payment. In order to qualify for the advertised price, traveler must pay entire tour (deposit and final payment) by cash or check. The discount for payment by cash or check will be made after final payments are received.

CANCELLATION POLICY: All cancellations must be received in writing. There will be a \$100 per person cancellation penalty assessed from the time of deposit to May 7, 2010. Forfeit \$500 from May 7, 2010 to June 29, 2010. Forfeit \$1,750 for cancellations received between June 29, 2010 and July 24, 2010. After July 24, 2010, there is no refund. Penalties will be according to the fax or postmark.

STATE DEPARTMENT & OTHER AGENCIES: From time to time the State Department (www.state.gov) and the Centers for Disease Control (www.cdc.gov) and other government agencies and departments issue travel advisories or warnings for one or more of the destinations that you may be visiting on tour. We encourage you to contact these agencies directly to obtain the most current information. Corporate Travel Service cannot change the cancellation terms or conditions based on the issuance of any such warning or advisory or the occurrence of any terror, health or other incident in one or more of the places this tour is scheduled to visit. All cancellation penalties must remain in full force and effect as outlined on the reservation form.

CANCELLATION INSURANCE: Corporate Travel Service HIGHLY RECOMMENDS the purchase of travel insurance. To receive the optimum insurance coverage, purchase travel insurance within 14 days of deposit. Call us at 313-565-8888 x 151 or 152.

ROOMS: Tour prices are per person according to a room type: a "Single" room is one person in a room and a "Double" is two persons in one room. "Triple" rooms are discouraged because of cramped quarters. Triples are one double bed with two persons sharing the bed and one single bed. Triples are not always available.

CHECKED LUGGAGE: Checked baggage is limited to one bag per person. There can be no exceptions. For most airlines, the one checked bag is limited to **50 pounds and 62 inches** (length + width + height). If these specifications are exceeded, excess charges may be collected by the airline at the airport. Do not lock baggage you intend to check in at the airport. Please confirm these specifications when you receive your final travel documents, as they can and do change.

CARRY ON LUGGAGE: You may also bring a small carry-on bag that will fit under an airline seat and on the small parcel racks of the motor coach, which average about 8 inches high by 18 inches deep. It is best if your carry-on bag is soft sided, as the parcel racks on the motor coaches are small. Currently, travellers are allowed to transport only small amounts of liquids, gels, lotions, aerosols or similar items on their person or in their carry-on luggage. Details will be in your final travel documents.

GRATUITIES: Unless otherwise noted as included, gratuities for your escort, driver and guides are not included. In Europe it is customary to tip the escort (3) Euros and the driver two (2) Euros per person per day. The tip for the local guides is usually about one (1) Euros for half-day tours and two (2) Euros for full day tours.

PASSPORT: A valid U.S. Passport is required of all passengers. Please apply for your passport immediately as passports are taking a long time to process. Make sure to have it in your possession at all times while on tour. **It must be valid for 6 months following the return date of the trip or boarding may be denied or entry into the destination may be forbidden.**

GROUP AIR: Due to the airlines' reduced capacity and restrictive group reservation terms, group air reservations are often difficult to coordinate. The number of connections, length of layovers, and all conditions surrounding air travel cannot be guaranteed and may change before departure. Accordingly, if you require specific air travel needs and are not flexible concerning group air travel, **you may wish to consider purchasing a Land-Only package** and secure your own preferred air arrangements. In this case, you must notify Corporate Travel Service no less than 120 days before departure, be responsible for meeting the group at a specified location and time on the tour, and sign a Corporate Travel Service Land Only Waiver. Land only passengers are responsible for arranging and the cost of transfers to and from the airport. Corporate Travel Service will not be responsible for any loss incurred by traveller due to a cancelled flight or other means of transportation. Please investigate purchasing travel insurance to cover any type of loss associated with cancelled air or other transportation.

Seat Requests: Please note that group seats are assigned "at the discretion of the airline", although every effort will be made to fulfill requests, **SPECIFIC SEAT ASSIGNMENTS CANNOT AND WILL NOT BE GUARANTEED.** Seat numbers will not be advised until check in at the airport. If you require specific seats, Corporate Travel Service suggests you book the tour package as "land only" and arrange your own air.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Unless otherwise notified, Corporate Travel Service will mail to you or your group leader a more detailed itinerary and General Information Sheet approximately 2 weeks or 10 days before departure.

ITINERARY: The Itinerary as presented in this brochure is tentative and represents what we are planning for you, however it is subject to confirmations from many organizations. Because of changes in local schedules, we may need to alter specified events, dates and/or venues to better fit the overall plan.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: Travellers must be medically and physically fit for this tour. This tour requires significant walking, as motor coaches are not permitted to pick up and drop off in front of major attractions. The tour is not wheelchair accessible. Should any special assistance be required, traveller agrees to bring a companion capable and willing to assist traveller. Any special medical conditions or equipment must be advised in writing, for evaluation of feasibility, at the time of making your reservation.

CHILDREN UNDER 18: For a minor under the age of 18 to travel out of the United States without both parents or legal guardians, a notarised affidavit must be obtained and presented to immigration officials upon departure and return to the United States. You may request a form from our office.
