





Greetings from the Eternal City!



### Thursday September 28 > Rome, Italy

Today attend the events correlating with the 2017 diaconate ordinations of the seminarians from the Pontifical North American College as presided by Bishop James Checchio, Bishop of Metuchen and former Rector of the North American College. (Transportation and accommodations on your own this day; cruise/tour begins tomorrow as the group gathers at Termini station to board train to Venice; contact Mark Randall for more details on the specifics of this day, or contact Corporate Travel for detailed travel arrangements).

### Friday, September 29 > Venice, Italy

After checking out of your Rome hotel, board the High-Speed Italo Train (in reserved 1st class seating) for a scenic ride to Venice. Upon arriving at Santa Lucia Railway station you will be swept away by the classic romance and beauty of Venice as you embark aboard the gorgeous Oceania Riviera—your home for the next 9 nights! Welcome cocktail party & group dinner this evening. Boarding begins at 1 pm

### Saturday, September 30 🗫 Koper, Slovenia

Take some time to explore the fortified Old Town of Venetian-influenced Koper, which has retained much of its grand architecture from the 15th to 18th centuries.

### Sunday, October 1 >> Ravenna, Italy

Perhaps enjoy a day touring diminutive San Marino, the world's oldest republic, which being inland has remained surprisingly intact since being founded in 301 A.D.

### Monday, October 2 > Zadar, Croatia

This hidden gem of the Adriatic offers beautiful beaches, charming promenades, preserved ancient architecture and fascinating historical monuments. Roman aqueducts, forums and temples surround the town center, which features medieval churches and monasteries.

### Tueday, October 3 > Kotor, Montenegro

Explore the maze-like streets of Kotor and discover impeccable Montenegrin hospitality in the many shops & restaurants.

### Wednesday, October 4 ^ Corfu, Greece

Get a taste of island life on Corfu. Sample some sweet kumquats in the Old Town markets or people watch over a cup of strong coffee in one of the many neighborhoods.

### Thursday, October 5 > Valletta, Malta

Discover Malta's myriad of cultural layers, from its amazing prehistoric temples at Tarxien, to beautiful walled medieval Mdina, and nearby Rabat.

### Friday, October 6 Catania, Sicily, Italy

Taormina offers sweeping Sicilian views nestled between the coast and Mt. Etna. Maybe visit the cliffside Greek Theater for a panoramic view of the volcano & sea.

### Saturday, October 7 Naples, Italy

Take a cliff side drive to the majestic Amalfi Coast and experience breathtaking views that just can't compare anywhere. Or discover the Isle of Capri & ruins of Pompeii! Farewell group dinner in specialty restaurant.
