

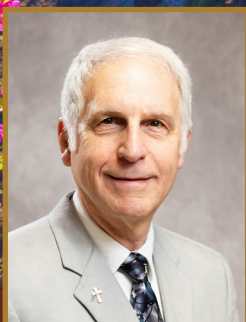

ATHENS

Visit the Areopagus, where Paul addressed the philosophers of Athens, then ascend the Acropolis to witness the splendor of classical Greece.

CORINTH

Explore this ancient city's treasures: the Agora, the Temple of Apollo, and the Bema, where Paul was brought before the Roman authorities.

EPHESUS

Explore the city where Paul preached and taught, and where the Virgin Mary lived out her final years in the care of John the Apostle.

PHILIPPI

Celebrate Mass at the stream where Paul baptized Lydia, the first European Christian. Visit the prison that held Paul and Silas.

Itinerary

Day 1 Monday, September 14

Depart for Athens

Depart on independent overnight flights to Athens, Greece, to begin your pilgrimage in the footsteps of St. Paul.

Day 2 Tuesday, September 15 🍽️

Arrival in Athens

Arrive in Athens and transfer to your hotel for check-in. Gather for Mass at the Cathedral of St. Dionysius the Areopagite. Pending arrival time, visit Daphni Monastery, a Byzantine site renowned for its breathtaking mosaic of Christ Pantocrator. In the evening, join your fellow pilgrims for a festive welcome dinner. Overnight in Athens.

Day 3 Wednesday, September 16 ☕ 🍽️

Corinth Excursion

Begin your pilgrimage with a visit to ancient Corinth. Explore this city's archaeological treasures, including the Agora, the Temple of Apollo, and the Bema—the place where Paul stood trial (Acts 18). Celebrate Mass at Holy Apostles Church before returning to Athens for dinner at a traditional Greek restaurant. Overnight in Athens.

Day 4 Thursday, September 17 ☕ 🍽️

Areopagus Hill | Acropolis | Embarkation

Check out of the hotel and follow in St. Paul's footsteps in Athens. Begin at the Areopagus, where Paul addressed the philosophers of Athens (Acts 17), then ascend to the Acropolis. Celebrate Mass at St. Paul's Church before transferring to the port of Piraeus to embark on your cruise aboard the Celebrity Infinity. Dinner and overnight onboard.

Day 5 Friday, September 18 ☕ 🍽️ 🍽️

Day at Sea

Enjoy a peaceful day at sea. Celebrate Mass onboard and take part in a group reflection. You'll also have time to relax and enjoy the ship's amenities, including dining venues, lounges, entertainment, and wellness areas. Overnight onboard.

Day 6 Saturday, September 19 ☕ 🍽️ 🍽️

Rhodes

Visit the Acropolis of Lindos and the Citadel of the Knights, then walk to the historic port where Paul landed (Acts 21:1). Celebrate Mass at the serene Santa Maria Monastery. Enjoy the afternoon at leisure before returning to the ship. Overnight onboard.

Day 7 Sunday, September 20 ☕ 🍽️ 🍽️

Kusadasi | Ephesus

Dock in Kusadasi and drive to Ephesus. Begin with Mass at the House of the Virgin Mary, then tour the ancient city of Ephesus, including the grand theater, Library of Celsus, and other remarkable ruins. Return to the ship for dinner and overnight.

Day 8 Monday, September 21 ☕ 🍽️ 🍽️

Santorini

Explore the stunning island of Santorini, where whitewashed buildings and blue-domed chapels overlook the Aegean Sea. Visit the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist in Fira and celebrate Mass. Overnight onboard.

Day 9 Tuesday, September 22 ☕ 🍽️ 🍽️

Mykonos

Arrive at Mykonos, known for its charming villages and crystalline waters. Celebrate Mass at the Church of Our Lady of the Rosary. Visit the Monastery of Panagia Tourliani in Ano Mera, home to Byzantine icons. Return to the ship for dinner and overnight.

Day 10 Wednesday, September 23 ☕ 🍽️ 🍽️

Kavala | Philippi

Travel to Kavala, the port where St. Paul first entered Europe. Continue to Philippi for a guided tour. See the ancient forum, early Christian basilicas, and the prison where Paul and Silas were held (Acts 16). Visit the site of St. Lydia's baptism and celebrate Mass. Return to the ship for dinner and overnight.

Day 11 Thursday, September 24 ☕ 🍽️ 🍽️

Thessaloniki | Berea | Vergina

Begin with a tour of Thessaloniki, the city to which St. Paul addressed two of his epistles. Celebrate Mass at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception. Continue to Berea, where the locals are praised in Acts 17:11 for eagerly receiving the Word. Return to the ship for dinner and overnight.

Day 12 Friday, September 25 ☕ 🍽️ 🍽️

Day at Sea

Spend your final full day at sea, enjoying the ship's amenities. Celebrate Mass and participate in a closing group reflection. Overnight onboard.

Day 13 Saturday, September 26 ☕

Return to Home

Disembark in Athens and transfer to the airport for return flights home.
