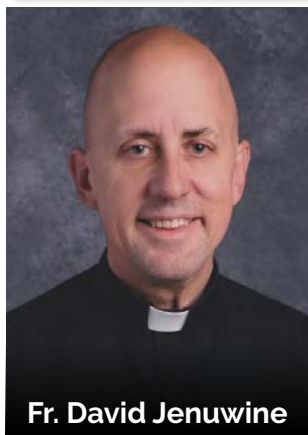

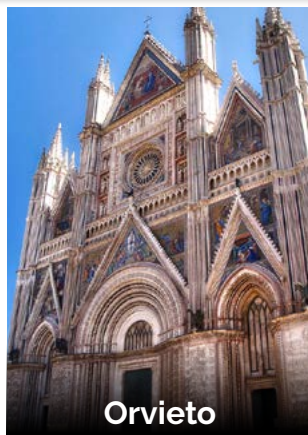

ITALY ITINERARY*

Day 1: Tuesday April 3rd • Depart for Italy

Overnight flights on scheduled air from Newark to Rome.

Day 2: Wednesday, April 4th • Assisi

Arrive in Rome and meet your Italian tour escort. Transfer by private motor coach to Assisi. Check in to the hotel and freshen up. **Celebrate an evening Mass at St. Mary of the Angels**, followed by a Welcome Dinner. Overnight in Assisi. (D)

Day 3: Thursday, April 5th • Assisi

Celebrate Mass at the Tomb of St. Francis in the morning, followed by a tour (pending confirmation). Then, visit the Church of St. Claire to see her tomb and the cross that spoke to St. Francis, the Cross of San Damiano. Take a city tour of Assisi and see the Church of San Rufino where St. Francis and St. Clare were baptized. In the afternoon, enjoy free time to stroll through this charming village with its quaint shops. Overnight in Assisi. (CB|D)



Day 4: Friday, April 6th • Assisi | Siena

Depart for a day trip to Siena. Upon arrival, celebrate a private Mass at Saint Francis Basilica in Siena, site of a Eucharistic Miracle. **After Mass, visit the Basilica of St. Domenico, site of the relic of St. Catherine of Siena.** Tour the famous Cathedral followed by a visit to the home of St. Catherine of Siena. Enjoy an exquisite lunch and wine tasting experience, indulging in the flavors of the region. Overnight in Assisi. (CB|L)

Day 5: Saturday, April 7th • Orvieto | Rome

After breakfast depart Assisi for the picturesque hilltop town of Orvieto. **Celebrate Mass at the Duomo**, and learn about the Eucharistic Miracle of Corpus Christi. See the famous cycle of frescoes by Signorelli which Michelangelo used as inspiration for his Last Judgement masterpiece. After a delicious lunch, featuring the regional cuisine and wine of Umbria, embrace free time to experience Orvieto, with its famous shops. Then, head south to Rome. Overnight in Rome. (CB|L)

Day 6: Sunday, April 8th • Rome | Optional Walking Tour

Divine Mercy Sunday. Celebrate Divine Mercy in the Eternal City! Enjoy a leisurely morning or partake in an optional walking tour to visit any of the following: Spanish Steps, Trevi Fountain and Piazza Navona. **Celebrate Mass and tour the Capuchin "bone church"**. Dinner and overnight in Rome. (CB|D)

Day 7: Monday, April 9th • Catacombs | Christian Rome



Today, visit the San Sebastian Catacombs. The 4th century catacombs burrow underground on four levels and are the burial sites of many early Christians and martyrs. After lunch, take a Christian Rome Tour, including

St. Mary Major and John in Lateran, which is the Cathedral of Rome. Then, head over to the San Sebastian Rotondo church (in the round). **The last visit will be at St. Paul's Outside the Walls where the group will celebrate Mass.** Overnight in Rome. (CB|D)

Day 8: Tuesday, April 10th • Vatican & Sistine Chapel | Scavi Tour

Celebrate Mass at the crypt in St. Peter's, in the morning (pending confirmation). Afterwards, enjoy a guided tour of the Vatican, including the Museums and the Sistine Chapel. Here you will view some of the most inspiring works of art, including Michelangelo's magnificent fresco of the Last Judgment. End with a tour of St. Peter's Basilica. In the afternoon, enjoy a Scavi tour: the underground excavations beneath the Basilica which culminates at the tomb of St. Peter (pending confirmation). Overnight in Rome. (CB)

Day 9: Wednesday, April 11th • Papal Audience | Coliseum & Roman Forum

Start your day by attending the weekly general Papal Audience (pending the Holy Father's final schedule.) After lunch, on your own, enjoy a tour of Ancient Rome, including the Coliseum (inside visit). **Celebrate Mass before having a special farewell dinner.** Overnight in Rome. (CB|D)

Day 10: Thursday, April 12th • Depart USA

Check out of the hotel and head to airport for your return flights to the USA. (CB)
