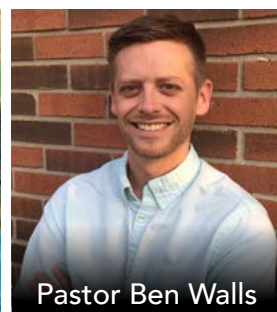

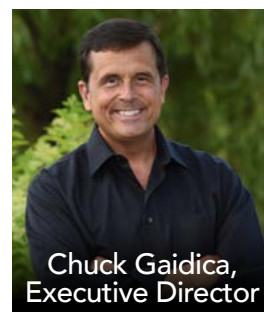

HOLY LAND TOUR: SEEK & CONNECT — ITINERARY*

Day 1: Friday, November 9: Depart USA

Depart USA on overnight flights to Tel Aviv, Israel.

Day 2: Saturday, Nov. 10: Arrive Tel Aviv | Sea of Galilee

Arrive in Tel Aviv and meet your professional tour escort, then transfer by private motor coach to the Sea of Galilee and check into your hotel in the town of Tiberias. This evening, enjoy a Welcome Dinner at the hotel in Tiberias. (D)

Day 3: Sunday, Nov 11: Megiddo | Nazareth

Depart early this morning to Megiddo, one of the most important archaeological sites from scripture and recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Then Travel to Nazareth and visit the grotto of the Incarnation. Enjoy time for lunch before returning to Tiberias. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias. (CB | D)

Day 4: Monday, Nov. 12: Mount of Beatitudes | Mt. Hermon | Banias | Tabgha

Drive to the Mount of Beatitudes where Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount. Continue on to the Golan Heights to view Mount Hermon, where Jesus met Moses and Elijah at the Transfiguration. Visit Caesarea Philippi, then travel to Tabgha, where Jesus performed the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and fish. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias. (CB | D)

Day 5: Tuesday, Nov. 13: Capernaum | Sea of Galilee | Jerusalem

Today, walk the banks of the Sea of Galilee, take a boat ride across the sea to Capernaum, and explore the town of Jesus. See the ancient synagogue where Jesus preached. Then, travel south through the Jordan Valley, seeing many biblical sites on the journey; look across to Moses' Mount Nebo and see Jericho through the Judean Wilderness. Time-permitting, stop near Jericho to view the Mount of Temptation and the tree of Zaccheus. Renew baptismal vows in the Jordan River and continue to Jerusalem for hotel check-in. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem. (CB | D)



Day 6: Wednesday, Nov. 14: Bethlehem | Garden Tomb

This morning depart for Bethlehem to visit Shepherds Field. Tour the Church of the Nativity and see the cave where Jesus was born. This afternoon visit and tour the Garden Tomb, said to be the Sepulchre of Joseph of Arimethea, located near Jeremiah's Grotto. Celebrate a communion service before visiting the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem. (CB | D)

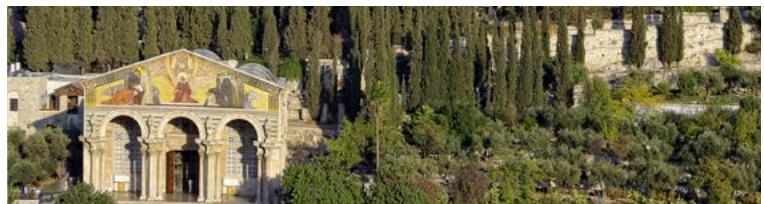
Day 7: Thursday, Nov. 15: Jerusalem | City of David | Mt. Zion

Begin today with a walking tour of the Old City of Jerusalem on the way to the Western Wall. Travel back in time to "see" the Temple as seen by Jesus. Tour the Old City of David and take time for lunch. In the afternoon visit Mount Zion, the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu ("where the cock crowed"), and walk the Roman steps. Visit the House of Caiaphas and see the pit where it is believed Jesus spent the night after His arrest. Walk along the same ancient hillside steps Jesus walked before being condemned. Visit the Upper Room (Cenacle) where the first Pentecost took place. The rest of the day is free for walking, reflecting, or shopping in the Old City of Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem. (CB | D)



Day 8: Friday, Nov 16: Mt. of Olives | Garden of Gethsemane

This morning, drive to the Mount of Olives and visit the Chapel of the Ascension where Jesus rose into heaven. See Mount Moriah and the Dome of the Rock from atop the Mount of Olives. Then walk in the Garden of Gethsemane, stopping to pray at the Grotto of the Arrest. Following this time of prayer, visit the Rabbinical Tunnels under the Western Wall. Enjoy a special farewell dinner and overnight in Jerusalem. (CB | D)



Day 9: Saturday, Nov. 17: Dead Sea | Qumran | Masada

Enjoy an expedition to swim in the Dead Sea. Next, visit Qumran and Masada. From a distance see Mt. Nebo in Jordan, where Moses viewed the Promised Land. Return to Jerusalem for dinner and packing. Partial overnight in Jerusalem (flights depart through the night.) (CB | D)

Day 10: Sunday, Nov. 18: Return to USA

Return home from Tel Aviv after a memorable spiritual journey to the Holy Land.
