

PILGRIMAGE TO OBERAMMERGAU*

Day 1 ☞ Sunday, Sept. 27 • Depart USA

Depart on overnight flights to Munich, Germany.

Day 2 ☞ Monday, Sept. 28 • Arrive in Munich | Salzburg

Arrive in Munich. Meet your English-speaking tour manager and transfer to Salzburg, a splendid city set on the banks of the Salzach River and the birthplace of Mozart. Upon arrival, celebrate Mass before enjoying a special Bavarian welcome dinner. Overnight in Salzburg. (D)

Day 3 ☞ Tuesday, Sept. 29 • Salzburg | Maria Plain Oberndorf | Austrian Alpine

Start the morning with a visit to the Shrine of Our Lady of Maria Plain, home to a miraculous image of Virgin Mary located above the altar where St. John Paul II prayed. Celebrate Mass and explore the Shrine before a delicious coffee break at the sanctuary's café, overlooking the city of Salzburg. Then, transfer to Oberndorf to visit the Silent Night Chapel where the song was originally performed on December 24th, 1818. Drive to Schloss Fuschl, a luxury resort, to enjoy lunch while overlooking one of the largest Austrian lakes, Fuschlsee. After lunch, board a private car to Schafberg Mountain on a 125-year-old steam powered train, the oldest still-functioning train in the world! Once at the summit, admire one of the best views of the Austrian Alps. Return to Salzburg for dinner on your own and overnight. (B|L)



Day 4 ☞ Wednesday, Sept. 30 • Salzburg | Seefeld



After breakfast, celebrate Mass at the Church of St. Maria of Loreto followed by time to admire the statue of Christ Child of Loreto, venerated for its miraculous powers. Then, depart on a city tour of Salzburg starting at Hohensalzburg Fortress for a bird's-eye view of the city. Conclude with a private tour of Stiegl Brewery, Austria's largest private brewery. The highlight will be a visit to the tasting cellar where a qualified beer sommelier will serve beer specialties and complementary food. Afterward, transfer to Seefeld. Upon arrival, check into the hotel with time to relax and freshen up before a group dinner. Overnight in Seefeld. (B|D)

Day 5 ☞ Thursday, Oct. 1 • Seefeld | Innsbruck | Wattens

This morning, celebrate Mass at St. Oswald Church, one of the most famous pilgrimage sites in Tyrol, known for the Seefeld Eucharistic Miracle. After Mass, hear the story of the 'Miracle of the Host'. See the hole in the ground where the knight sank to his knees and his handprints, which can still be seen on the original stone altar. Transfer to Innsbruck for a guided tour of the old city, the capital of the Tyrol Province. Experience the culture, the top local attractions and witness the charming architecture of Old Town. Then, depart for Wattens to visit the Swarovski Museum, one of Austria's most popular attractions. Experience an enchanting world of crystals in the 'Chambers of Wonder' and their expansive garden. Return to Seefeld for dinner on your own and overnight. (B)

Day 6 ☞ Friday, Oct. 2 • Ettal Monastery | Oberammergau Passion Play

Breakfast at the hotel before departing for Oberammergau. Along the way, stop to admire Zugspitze, the highest mountain in Germany. Then, visit Ettal Monastery, a stunning example of Baroque architecture. Celebrate Mass and explore the grounds. Upon arrival in Oberammergau, lunch will be provided in the village. Then, attend the 1st Act of the world-famous Oberammergau Passion Play. The history of the Passion Play goes back to the year 1634. The quaint alpine village of Oberammergau was threatened by the Black Plague that scourged Europe, killing two-thirds of the population in Germany. The people of Oberammergau vowed that if the village could be spared, a re-enactment of the life and suffering of Christ would be performed. The village was miraculously saved from the ravages of the Black Death. Now, the play is performed every ten years. During intermission, have a meal at a local restaurant and enjoy dinner and free time for souvenir shopping. Afterward, attend the 2nd Act of the Passion Play. Overnight in the Oberammergau vicinity. (B|L|D)



Day 7 ☞ Saturday, Oct. 3 • Oberammergau | Wies | Neuschwanstein Castle | Munich

After breakfast, transfer amidst green meadows and snowcapped mountains to visit and celebrate Mass at the "Wiekirche" (Church of the Scourged Savior) perched atop a small rise in a meadow at the foot of the Alps. Learn the history of this undisputed highlight of Bavarian rococo architecture. Enjoy a group lunch, before visiting Neuschwanstein Castle, an embodiment of 19th century romanticism. In a fantastical imitation of a medieval castle, Neuschwanstein is spectacularly sited on a high point over the Pollat River Gorge. Continue to Munich and check into the hotel. Enjoy an evening of leisure to explore the city and have dinner on your own. Overnight in Munich. (B|L)



Day 8 ☞ Sunday, Oct. 4 • Munich Oktoberfest

Today, celebrate Mass before participating in the last day of the world-famous Oktoberfest festivities with dinner included at a local beer tent. Overnight in Munich. (B|D)

Day 9 ☞ Monday, Oct. 5 • Munich

After a morning of leisure, enjoy a city tour of Munich. Visit Marienplatz, Munich's central square to see the historic Glockenspiel, Town Hall with its magnificent boulevard, and Residenz (exterior view), a palace of the kings of Bavaria. Conclude with a farewell dinner at a famous local restaurant known for its exclusive hospitality and exquisite traditional German cuisine. (B|D)

Day 10 ☞ Tuesday, Oct. 6, 2020 • Return to USA

Check out of hotel and depart on group transfer to Munich International Airport for your return flights home.
