

itinerary

DAY 1: MONDAY, APRIL 12 – DEPART USA FOR SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA, SPAIN

Depart the USA on independent scheduled flights to Santiago de Compostela, Spain (SCQ)*.

DAY 2: TUESDAY, APRIL 13 – SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA | SARRIA

Upon arrival in Santiago de Compostela, collect your bags and depart via a group transfer* to the city of Sarria. Upon arrival, check into your hotel and cherish time to acclimate yourselves to the local time and explore the city. Celebrate Mass at a local church followed by a welcome dinner. Overnight in Sarria, Spain.

DAY 3: WEDNESDAY, APRIL 14 – SARRIA | PORTOMARIN 14.3 MILES

After breakfast at the hotel, pick up your boxed lunch (as you will each morning) and begin your hike. Your first stop, after 14 miles of hiking, will be the village of Portomarin, dating back to the Roman Age. It was an important stop along the route in the Middle Ages. Celebrate Mass. Then, check in and freshen up before enjoying dinner together. Overnight in Portomarin.

DAY 4: THURSDAY, APRIL 15 – PORTOMARIN | PALAS DE REI 15 MILES

This morning after breakfast, set off into the woods for your journey towards Palas de Rei. On the 15 miles of hilly walk, travel through fields and forests while passing countless granaries, hórreos, and wayside crosses. Celebrate Mass. Upon arrival in Palas de Rei check in and freshen up before dinner. Overnight in Palas de Rei.

DAY 5: FRIDAY, APRIL 16 – PALAS DE REI | RIBADISO | ARZUA 18 MILES

After breakfast, begin a long day of walking to the small town of Arzua. On the way you will cross a Medieval bridge which leads pilgrims to Ribadiso, a town famous for its Galician cheese. Visit the Gothic Chapel of Magdalena, the only portion of the ancient Augustinian monastery still standing. Celebrate Mass. Upon arrival in Arzua, after covering nearly 18 miles, check into hotel and freshen up before dinner. Overnight in Arzua.

DAY 6: SATURDAY, APRIL 17 – ARZUA | PEDROUZA 11 MILES

Today your trek will continue across the countryside and end in Arca do Pino (Pedrouza), the largest community before Santiago. Celebrate Mass, check in, rest and enjoy dinner together. Overnight in Pedrouza.

DAY 7: SUNDAY, APRIL 18 – PEDROUZO | SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA 14 MILES

This morning, set out to make the last and final stage of your Camino journey before reaching the famed city of Santiago de Compostela. En route stop at the Monte del Gozo (Mount Joy) from which the spires of the Cathedral are first visible. Upon arrival in the Cathedral Square, enjoy time for prayer before obtaining your "Compostela", or certificate of completion of the journey. Check into your hotel. Celebrate a pilgrim Mass at the Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela. (Please note: the Cathedral will likely still be under restoration and have limited access. The Bontofumeiro Mass will not be available). Dinner as a group and overnight in Santiago.

DAY 8: MONDAY, APRIL 19 – DAY AT LEISURE | SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

After breakfast, visit and celebrate Mass at the Cathedral of St. James, one of the finest examples of architecture in all of Europe. Enjoy the time in the Cathedral to hug the statue of St. James, pray at his relics and participate in the sacrament of confession (pending stage of restorations). The remainder of the day will be at leisure to explore Santiago, rest or shop. Farewell dinner this evening and overnight in Santiago.

DAY 9: TUESDAY, APRIL 20 – DEPART FOR USA

Following a physically exhaustive and spiritually moving journey transfer to the Santiago airport for independently scheduled return flights*.
