

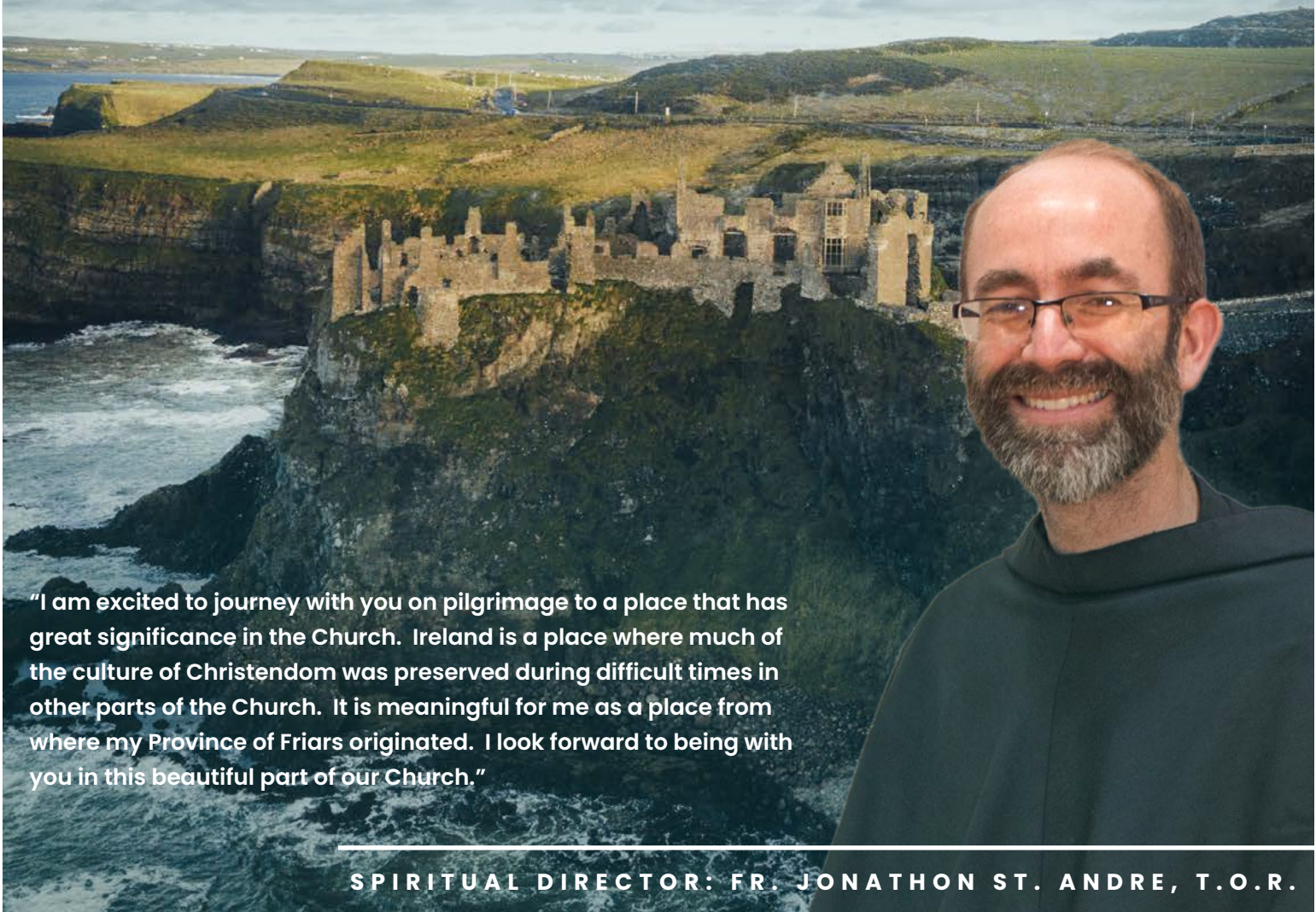

## itinerary

### DAY 1: FRIDAY, OCTOBER 9 • DEPART USA

Depart USA on overnight flights to Ireland's capital city, Dublin.

### DAY 2: SATURDAY, OCTOBER 10 • DUBLIN | GALWAY

Arrive at Dublin Airport where you will be met with a cead mile failte (a hundred thousand welcomes) by your Irish Tour Director. Travel north to visit Silverstream Priory, a house of Benedictine monks committed to ceaseless prayer before the Holy Sacrament. Continue west to the ancient monastery of Clonmacnoise, founded in 544 by St Kieran. Celebrate Mass in the Pope's Shelter. End in Galway with its rich history, quaint narrow streets, shops, galleries, lively pubs and great traditional music. Enjoy welcome dinner and overnight.

*Day's schedule is pending arrival time of the group in Dublin.*

### DAY 3: SUNDAY, OCTOBER 11 • KNOCK SHRINE | TUAM | GALWAY

After breakfast, depart for Westport and Croagh Patrick, Ireland's holiest mountain to see where St. Patrick fasted for forty days in 441 AD, a custom handed down through generations. Though time will not permit the traditional climb, the group will visit and venerate this holy site. Continue to Ireland's most famous pilgrimage site at Knock where Our Lady appeared in 1879. Explore the grounds, outdoor Stations, and celebrate Mass in Apparition Chapel. End with a visit to the town where the TORs are from, Tuam. Dinner on your own and overnight in Galway.

### DAY 4: MONDAY, OCTOBER 12 • GALWAY

Today travel around Lough Corrib and Connemara, Ireland's most extensive Gaelic speaking area. Visit Kylemore Abbey and celebrate Mass with the Irish Benedictine nuns before returning to Galway for some time at leisure. Dinner on your own and overnight in Galway.

### DAY 5: TUESDAY, OCTOBER 13 • CLIFFS OF MOHER | KILLARNEY

Depart Galway and travel south to the breathtaking Cliffs of Moher, Ireland's most visited attraction. In the afternoon arrive in Killarney, with its wonderful scenery surrounded by the Killarney National Park. Celebrate Mass in the beautiful neo-Gothic St. Mary's Cathedral.

Check in to the hotel, followed by dinner on your own and overnight in Killarney.

### DAY 6: WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 14 • DINGLE PENINSULA

After breakfast, travel along Dingle Bay with views of the Iveragh Peninsula to the fishing town of Dingle. Celebrate Mass in St. Mary's, built in 1862. Time at leisure, before taking the spectacular Sleat Head drive along the Atlantic Ocean. See the ruins of the Romanesque Kilmalkeader Church, associated with both St. Brendan the Navigator and St. Maolcethair. End the day at Muckross Traditional Farms & School House for an evening of music, dinner, entertainment and a taste of life in Ireland. Overnight in Killarney.

### DAY 7: THURSDAY, OCTOBER 15 • ROCK OF CASHEL | DUBLIN

Travel over the Cork/Kerry border and stop to visit the Rock of Cashel, one of Ireland's oldest religious sites and the place where St. Patrick converted hundreds by his preaching. Celebrate Mass in the beautifully restored Holy Cross Abbey with its relic of the True Cross.

Continue to Dublin for dinner on your own and overnight in Dublin.

### DAY 8: FRIDAY, OCTOBER 16 • CITY TOUR | DUBLIN



Travel through the Wicklow Mountains to the 6th Century Monastic Site of St. Kevin in Glendalough, the glaciated valley of the two lakes. Celebrate Mass in St. Kevin's Church before touring the monastic site, followed by free time for prayer and reflection. End the day with a tour of the Guinness Storehouse, admiring the spectacular views of the city. Dinner on your own and overnight in Dublin.

### DAY 9: SATURDAY, OCTOBER 17 • DUBLIN

Visit Trinity College and see the magnificent Book of Kells, a 9th century illuminated manuscript of the Four Gospels, followed by St. Patrick's Cathedral where Jonathan Swift was once Dean. Celebrate Mass in Dublin's Pro-Cathedral. The afternoon is free for shopping or sightseeing on your own. This evening enjoy a traditional Irish Farewell Dinner. Overnight in Dublin.

### DAY 10: SUNDAY, OCTOBER 18 • RETURN TO USA

Bid goodbye to the Emerald Isle and newfound friends before the return flight from Dublin Airport.
