Itinerary

(Subject to final confirmation)

DAY 1: DEPART THE USA

Depart USA today on overnight flights to Krakow, Poland.

DAY 2: ARRIVE IN KRAKOW

Upon arrival in Krakow, meet your local, Polish tour manager and transfer to your hotel for check-in. Enjoy a welcome dinner as a group. Overnight in Krakow.

DAY 3: KRAKOW

After breakfast at the hotel, depart for a guided tour of the city. Visit the Wawel Cathedral, where St. John Paul II was ordained a priest and celebrated his first Mass. Walk along Kanonicza Street where St. John Paul II resided as a priest and bishop. Afterwards, attend the opening of the Wit Stwoszcz altar at St. Mary's "Mariacki" Church. Lunch on own. This afternoon, perform at a local historic church in Krakow such as St. Peter and Paul, St. Anna's, St. Mary's, or St. Catherine. Enjoy dinner as a group and overnight in Krakow.

DAY 4: AUSCHWITZ | WADOWICE | KALWARIA ZEBRZYDOWSKA

This morning, depart for Auschwitz to visit the most infamous of the World War II concentration camps. See the cell of St. Maximilian Kolbe, and, before departing, sing a solemn hymn of remembrance to those who lost their lives so tragically there. Continue on to Wadowice, birthplace of St. John Paul II. Visit his house, now a museum. See the font where he was baptized at the Basilica of the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Lunch on your own. This afternoon, visit Kalwaria – the Polish Jerusalem. The shrine is dedicated to the Passion of Christ and to the miraculous Icon of the Virgin Mary. It was a favorite pilgrimage place for St. John Paul II.

Return to Krakow for dinner on your own and overnight.

DAY 5: ZAKOPANE

Depart for the scenic hills of Zakopane, a favorite recreational retreat of St. John Paul II. Take a gondola ride to Mt. Gubalowka for a bird's eye view of the city and hillsides of Zakopane. Enjoy a "highlander's lunch" at a traditional mountaineer restaurant. This afternoon, visit Fatima Church, which was built by the mountaineers in gratitude for the Blessed Mother saving the life of St. John Paul II from the assassination attempt. Return to Krakow for dinner and overnight.

DAY 6: DIVINE MERCY SHRINE FESTIVAL CHORUS

Depart for nearby Divine Mercy Shrine. Participate in a once in a lifetime Festival Choir Performance for Divine Mercy Sunday Mass.** After, explore the site where St. Faustina Kowalska, Apostle of Divine Mercy, lived and died. Group lunch before enjoying free time in downtown Krakow this afternoon and evening. Dinner on your own and overnight in Krakow.

DAY 7: KRAKOW

This morning, visit the "Have No Fear" Center dedicated to St. John Paul II and take time to pray by the relics of this great saint. Lunch on own. Afterward, tour the world famous Wieliczka Salt Mine, known for its beautiful and unique underground constructions made of salt, including Biblical icons and a statue of St. John Paul II carved from salt. Dinner and overnight in Krakow.

DAY 8: RETURN TO USA

Following a once in a lifetime performance tour to Poland for Divine Mercy Sunday, transfer to the airport in Krakow for return flights to the USA.
